



DIAMONDS Scholar Application

Debuting in 2023 in conjunction with the inaugural DIAMONDS storytelling gala, the **DIAMONDS Scholar** program is administered annually by the Founders Commission. Eligible to graduating high school students in Boone, Ogle, Stephenson and Winnebago counties, DIAMONDS Scholar scholarships are awarded for post-secondary schooling and/or technical training.

To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must be 2025 graduating high school students from Boone, Ogle, Stephenson or Winnebago counties who will be attending post-secondary educational institutions (i.e. college/university, community college, university, technical, trades school) during the 2025-26 school year. For scholarship awardees, Founders Commission will present a check written in the name of each awardee to her/his appropriate post-secondary school account.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

DIAMONDS Scholar consideration will be given to applicants who:

- Are a high school graduating student residing in Boone, Ogle, Stephenson or Winnebago counties
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0/4.0
- Have a demonstrated ability to thrive under pressure while embodying excellence
- Showcase a commitment to volunteerism in the Rockford region
- Submit a completed application by the due date
- Scholarships may endure on annual basis through four years of the winning applicant's post-secondary education if the student (1) maintains a minimum post-secondary grade point average of 2.5/4.0 and (2) completes at least 10 hours of volunteer community service work per semester

- September 19, 2024: Applications Open
- January 31, 2025: Applications Due
- February-March 2025: Review Period
- April 2025: Scholarship winner(s) finalized
- Spring/Summer 2025: Scholarship Winner(s) Recognized at DIAMONDS
